Federal Trade Commission Warns of "Shark Tank" Scams

"Shark Tank" is a popular TV show, where entrepreneurs take their shot at earning a celebrity's investment. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) published a warning on Feb. 17, 2023 about "Shark Tank" fraudulent endorsements. The FTC provided three warnings.



- Approach celebrity testimonials with caution
 - Look for product reviews on your own. Search the product online and put words like "scam" or "problems" or "complaints" to see what others are saying about the products.
- Go directly to the source.
 - Don't click on a link or ad. Instead, check out a full list of all businesses that have been on the show at abc.com/SharkTank.
- Remember: the government doesn't review or evaluate supplements for safety or effectiveness before they're put on the market.
 - Your health care professional is the most important person to ask whether a supplement is safe for you. Even a natural supplement can be risky depending on your health and the medicine you take
